

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), has scheduled a public meeting to discuss the Santa Rosa Sound Alternate Crossing Study in Okaloosa County. The meeting will be held in an open-house format **Tuesday, September 20**, from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. Central Daylight Time (CDT) at the Emerald Coast Convention Center, 1250 Miracle Strip Parkway, S.E., Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

The meeting is being held to present progress to date and obtain comments on the corridor alternatives under evaluation. The meeting will be held in an open-house format and will include a presentation video. Maps, graphics, and other project information will be on display for review. FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

What is the purpose of the study?

The Santa Rosa Sound Alternate Crossing Study is a high-level planning study that focuses on the feasibility for an alternate road and bridge corridor between Fort Walton Beach and Okaloosa Island. At the conclusion of the study, FDOT will make a decision whether to proceed to the next phase, a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study, for this project.

Why is the project needed?

An alternate corridor is being considered as a means to relieve traffic congestion along U.S. 98 in downtown Fort Walton Beach.

WHAT HAS HAPPENED SO FAR?

Initial Corridor Creation

Land Suitability Mapping (LSM) was used to determine possible locations for a potential alternate corridor. The LSM process is a method in which data representing natural, physical and socio-cultural features within the project area is used to screen for potential alternate corridors that may be suitable for further analysis. The LSM process, along with input from the project's Stakeholder Advisory Group, resulted in 10 initial alternative corridors to be further evaluated.

Agency Coordination

As part of the FDOT Efficient Transportation Decision Making (ETDM) process, environmental agencies reviewed the 10 initial alternative corridors and provided feedback on the potential natural, physical, and social effects resulting from these corridors. The feedback received from the environmental agencies is available at https://etdmpub.fla-etat.org/est/# (project #14236).

Develop Methodology to Compare Corridors

In order to systematically compare the alternative corridors, a memorandum detailing the methods of evaluation was submitted to the environmental agencies for their review and approval (March 2016). The Methodology Memorandum (MM) provided the goals of the evaluation, the methodology to be used, a plan for stakeholder coordination, and the basis for decision-making on potential corridors.

Corridor Comparative Analysis

The alternative corridors were evaluated for their involvement with seven evaluation categories: Primary Purpose and Need; Secondary Purpose and Need; Social Environment; Cultural Resources; Natural Environment; Physical Environment; and Engineering, Cost and Operation. The results of the evaluation will be presented at the Corridor Alternatives public meeting and will be documented in an Alternative Corridor Evaluation Report (ACER). A draft ACER will be submitted to FDOT after inclusion of public feedback from this meeting.

Public Outreach Activities

Public outreach activities to date include Okaloosa-Walton Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) briefings (April 16, 2015 and February 18, 2016), a Public Kickoff Meeting (April 23, 2015) and Stakeholder Advisory Group meetings (September 1, 2015 and February 11, 2016). You must meet the requirements of Florida Statute 633.34, Firefighter qualification for employment.

You must have a high school diploma or G.E.D

You must have a clean record. (Prior arrests or convictions will be reviewed against the Florida Statutes to determine eligibility).

Your driving record will be reviewed.

You must be in good physical health, tobacco-free for twelve (12) months prior to applying and be able to perform the tasks associated with the duties of a Firefighter.

PART 1 Application

1. Complete the application in full.

- a. Attach copies of any licensures or certifications that you have. A resume may also be attached.
- b. Attach a copy of your high school diploma (or G.E.D) and any college degree(s) to the application.
