

ORDINANCE NO. 79-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 77-4 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 77-8; AMENDING SECTION 8, PARAGRAPH 8 CHANGING THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE OKALOOSA ISLAND FIRE DISTRICT; REPEALING ALL PORTIONS OF THE SAID ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKALOOSA COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS:

Section 1. Secion 8, Paragraph 8, of Ordinance 77-8 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8: Funding.

(8) The fiscal year for the District shall be from October 1 to September 30 of each year."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Board of County Commissioners of Okaloosa County, Florida, pursuant to the Emergency Enactment Procedure, Florida Statutes, Chapter 126.66 (3).


